## Value Proposition

- Early career participants will benefit from knowledge transfer; build contacts
- The conference will benefit from early career perspective, ideas, change, and future vision/mission
- Future IASMiRT administrative and technical coordination positions will have a potential list of candidates

# Methodology

- Volunteers sought from the ISC to populate the informal committee
- Committee identified five possible initiatives during the fall of 2013
- Dialogued on the five through 2014 and "voted" to promote two initiatives

### First Proposed Initiative

- Early bird registration fee applicable to all early career attendees regardless of the deadline
- Implementation:
  - Define early career as those starting their career in the nuclear sector within the last 10 years.
  - Board and organizers review budget impact. (Viewed as cost neutral since those deciding to attend after the early bird deadline would otherwise not attend.)
  - Organizers modify online registration to allow early bird fee after the deadline. (Honor system will be invoked since verifying when attendees began their career would be subjective and laborious.)
  - Organizers capture self identification as early career and specify on name tags.
  - Board baselines and monitors early career attendance over multiple conferences.

## Second Proposed Initiative

- 2. "Hour with an Expert" forums offered for self identified early career participants
- Implementation:

- targets and solicits two experts on two topics to volunteer
- works with organizers to schedule forums
- provides moderators prepared with questions to elicit discussion
- works with organizers to advertise and promote
- works with organizers to provide refreshments and a casual venue
- solicits feedback from participants.
