

Plans are for special room rates for attendees



First steps in the Conference Organization

- First thoughts on the International Scientific Committee (ISC) have begun within the Steering committee
- The ISC will be set up according to IASMiRT good practice and will include two to three SMiRT/ISC experienced experts for each division
- A strong emphasis on the exchange of young and experienced participants will be organized through the organization of special workshops, collaboration with the Young Generation Network of the European Nuclear Society and universities or offering young member awards
- Contacts with SMiRT 25 are being established to learn from experience

Interaction with the Board



- Close contact to the Board through Astrid Petersen's membership in the Board (e. g. Conference manual, best practice discussions)
- Being the 50th anniversary it is planned to put special emphasis on celebratory activities including e. g. retrospective passages during plenary sessions (50 years of ...), a panel with former SMiRT presidents outlining the "next 50 years", and Thomas Jaeger memories
- These celebratory activities will be organized in close cooperation with the IASMiRT 50th Anniversary Committee; contact will be made soon
